All training sessions are led by UEFA qualified coaches Adam Davidson & Robert Prior. Enrolled students can expect a full-time training program that includes three weekly training sessions on a 4G all-weather pitch, a bi-weekly 30-minute video analysis session and 20+ competitive ECFA fixtures over the course of the academic year.

Professional football academies across the globe are increasingly using performance analysis to optimise the learning environments they create for their players.

We want to create that same experience for our students here at Priority Football Academy; allowing them to get to grips with the tools and resources used in the professional game whilst working alongside coaches and analysts with decades of experience in the sports industry.

FACILITIES

A MODERN LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

ON THE PITCH


Our training sessions take place on state of the art facilities at Nailsea School, including a 4G all-weather floodlit pitch, an indoor futsal hall and a grass pitch with running track.

We use GPS-tracking technology to monitor students' physical outputs and manage their training load each week. We also use data & video, where possible, to inform session design and to reinforce technical/tactical concepts.

OFF THE PITCH

Students work closely with our dedicated performance analyst who combines data and video to provide a more complete understanding of our past performances and future opponents.

Post-match video analysis and strength & conditioning sessions are used to support match preparation, training topics and physical recovery.

ABOUT

Nailsea School was re-built in 2009 to reflect a bright, modern centre of learning. Many of the classrooms and staff bases have glass walls creating openness and visibility around the school. Nailsea School's vision is to build a nurturing community where students are valued and supported to reach their full potential, developing the skills and qualifications needed for future success.

TRAVEL AND LOCATION

Nailsea and Backwell railway station is a 15-minute walk from the School and has direct links from both Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. Nailsea School is also fortunate enough to be on a main bus route that services many of the towns across North Somerset and is situated within 3 minutes' walk of Nailsea's shopping centre.

LEVEL 3 BTEC

Beginning in Sept. 2023, Priority Football Academy will introduce a Level 3 BTEC National Extended Diploma in Sport & Exercise for interested students in Nailsea School (equivalent to A levels) that incorporates a full-time football program into their academic timetable.

A LEVELS

Since 2019, Priority Football Academy has operated out of Nailsea School as an optional enrichment activity for students undertaking 3 A levels. From Sept. 2023, we will continue to provide this option for A level students albeit on a severely reduced timetable & exposure.
